

  - 7) **One Block of Cantrell Avenue (from Tamarac Street to Fig Street)**
  - 8) **McDowell Avenue (from Beech Street to Oak Street)**
  - 9) **Oak Street (from McDowell Avenue to Hwy 97)**
- d. **Sidewalk Project.**
  - 1) **Hwy 16 Sidewalk Project (from Hwy 97 to Tamarac Street on both sides of Hwy 16)**
