SWIM LESSON REGISTRATION FORM

The City of Jourdanton offers a **swimming lessons program. Register in person at City Hall.**

SWIM CLASS: 2023 Summer Session I: Tues. June 13- June 30th 2023 OR 2023 Summer Session II: Wed. July 5th- July 21st, 2023

- The group classes will involve approximately 12 classes over a three-week period.
- In person registration and payment at city hall. No refunds.
- An advanced payment of \$50.00 per participant for City of Jourdanton residents (priority) is required.
- Based on class availability, the visitor – non-resident- swimming lesson participant fee is \$60.00.
- Regular and punctual attendance is required in order to continue in the swimming class.
- The classes consist of approximately twelve 45 -minute sessions taught by certified lifeguards.
- No walk-ins once classes have started. No refunds for missed classes.

ALL SWIMMERS WILL BE TESTED ON THE FIRST DAY TO CONFIRM CLASS ASSIGNMENT AND TIME SLOT- INITIAL

- **BEGINNER CLASS: Learn the Basics.** Learn to swim. Learn the basic strokes. Learn water safety. Float on the back as a safety measure; be familiar with simple rescue measures.
- **SWIMMER CLASS: Improve Swimming Skills and Strokes.** Able to swim free style 25 yards and float on the back. Gain proficiency in the swimming strokes.
- **ADVANCED SWIMMER CLASS: Swim for Fitness:** Refine the front crawl, back crawl, sidestroke, breaststroke, endurance.

2023 CITY OF JOURDANTON AQUATIC CENTER RULES

- In case of an emergency, dial 911.
- The maximum number of swimmers allowed in the pool is 216.
- Persons under the age of 14 must not be in the pool without adult supervision.
- Patrons are responsible for their own valuables and personal items.
- Do not drink the recirculated Splash Pad water. Water shoes suggested for Splash Pad.
- During a random called lifeguard mock drill or an actual emergency all swimmers must immediately get out of the pool and sit on the pool deck until entry is authorized.
- Swimming is permitted ONLY when a lifeguard(s) is on duty.
- All patrons must take a shower before entering the pool.
- NO running, boisterous or rough play, profanity, or disrespectful behavior.
- Any person under the influence of alcohol or drugs is prohibited from the Aquatic Center.
- Patrons with skin, eye, ear or respiratory infections or open lesions or wounds are prohibited from entering the pool.
No spitting or blowing nose or urinating in the pool.
- No pets other than service animals will be allowed in the Aquatic Center.
- NO food or beverages or gum allowed in the pool. NO glass is allowed in the Aquatic Center.
- Alcoholic beverages are prohibited in the Aquatic Center.
- Charcoal / gas grills are prohibited in the Aquatic Center.
- Smoking is not allowed in the pool nor the deck area.
- Approved swimming attire, i.e., made of Lyra, spandex, or nylon, is required in the pool. No street clothes or shoes, cutoffs, denim shorts, or loose-fitting basketball shorts in the pool. Men's and women's swimwear must have a liner.
- Mask, fins and snorkels are not permitted.
- Any child not potty trained must wear an approved water-resistant swim diaper in the pool.
- Balloons must be secured on the fence. No balloon release. No Styrofoam floats.
- A first aid kit is located at the Ticket Office (Entrance).
- Automated External Defibrillator (AED) is located at the Ticket Office (Entrance).
- No refunds due to a weather-related pool closure. No bills over \$20.
- City management reserves the right to require any patron to leave for non-compliance with the above rules. All persons must comply with lifeguard orders. No refund if departure is required.

AQUATIC FACILITY LEADERSHIP AND OVERSIGHT

The City Manager overseeing the Aquatic Center staff has previously been certified as an American Red Cross Water Safety Instructor- an all-level swim instructor, including certifying of Lifeguards; and certified by the Boy Scout of America (BSA) as an Aquatic Director- as an all-level swim instructor, including training of lifeguards. His aquatic program experience includes working at municipal pools (5 seasons); private club pools (3 seasons); and Boy Scout District Camp Aquatic Director (1 season); and he was trained as a FEMA Emergency Management Coordinator. The City Manager has taught, qualified, and/or certified over 1,000+ swimmers during his aquatic experiences.

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
